## Accomplishments on behalf of the orphans

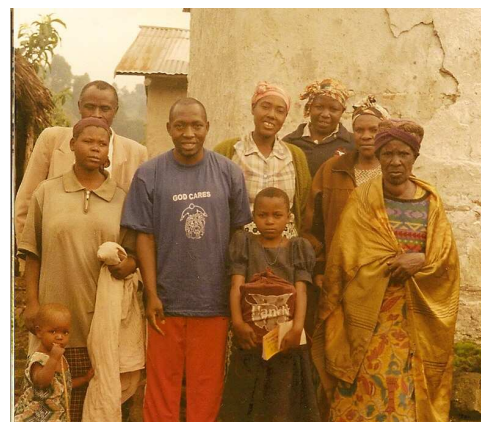

### School Visitation

During the month, we were able to pay some school dues for some Muko HOPE children. The paying of school fees gave a chance to me to know better where children are studying. School administrators welcomed me to their schools and promised to continue guiding our children for quality education. It is our plan as an office (social worker and volunteers) to see that all schools are visited. During the visitation, it was noted that several of our children study in 3<sup>rd</sup> world schools which perform poorly and it will be a miracle to achieve some of our objectives.

### Home Visitation

I did some visitation to see the living condition of our children. All children were found to be healthy and promising. Home visitations will continue to be carried out so that children and their guardians may be empowered through the counsel and advice from SOS.



### Buying Bibles

We want to thank Almighty God for the Bibles we received. We thank God for our partners in Michigan and may you be blessed richly and keep up with the spirit. On these bibles we recommend that children and guardians continue to be sensitized about the importance of the Bibles and how to keep them safe. Children and guardians were told that the word of God is a lamp to guide them and a light for their path.

### Updating children's files

We are glad that at least all Muko-HOPE children now have files. We are continuing to update these files to contain all the information needed in them.

### Career guidance and counseling

We are still providing some career guidance and counseling to our children working hand in hand with class teachers in their respective schools. We hope if the exercise continues children will see the good with education and rise to higher levels in their education.

### Distribution



We carried out distribution of items to the children which included Bibles, flasks, bed sheets, spoons, soap, and toothpaste. Guardians and children were told how to maintain these items. They were told to safe guard them if they are to be of great use. Guardians and children thank the MMU Task Force and sponsors for their care.

### Sponsor Letter writing

In the month of July 2008, we started to write correspondence letters. The office is also working around the clock to print good designed letters for children to use in writing but otherwise, we thank God for that progress.
